Dear Property Owner:

This notice is to inform you of a mandatory, upcoming inspection of all service lines connected to the East Berlin Area Joint Authority (EBAJA) water distribution system.

In 2021 the Federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published the Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR), which, in accordance with 40 CFR, Section 141.84, requires all community water systems regulated by the PA Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to complete and submit an initial Service Line Inventory (SLI) to the DEP by October 16, 2024.

Failing to complete and submit a SLI to DEP by October 16, 2024 will result in the water system (EBAJA) being in violation of the National Drinking Water Regulations, specifically 40 CFR, Section 141.84.

**Due to the federal mandate, compliance with this inspection is not optional.** According to EBAJA Ordinance 1-2008 Section 7 E, properly authorized and identified representative(s) of the Authority shall have full and free access to the consumer premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of inspections. Please make sure the operators will be able to safely access the water meter(s) on your property in order to conduct the required service line inspection.

Inspection of water service lines inside borough buildings will be conducted over the next 12 months. You will be alerted of the date / time the inspections will be conducted in your neighborhood. We understand that your time is valuable, so if you would like to schedule an appointment for a date and time that is conducive to your personal schedule, please contact the authority office by calling **717-259-8370** or emailing **ebajauthority@gmail.com**.
